Strike in Norway

After long negotiations over the weekend the parties in the Norwegian forwarding agent contract, Logistikk og Transportindustriens Landsforening LTL (Logistics and Transport Industry National Association) and Norsk Transportarbejderforbund NTF (Norwegian Transport Workers' Federation) were unable to reach a prospective collective agreement. The consequence is a conflict in the transport field, where NTF has chosen to go on strike at various terminals and offices in Norway as from May 15th. The strike has intensified further and now contains even more companies in Norway, and will initiate May 25th.

We therefore wish to inform, that there might be a great risk of disturbances in both terminal handling and in the Norwegian distribution system. Unfortunately this might mean that the risk of delay is vast.

However, part and full loads remain largely unaffected by the above.

We kindly ask for your understanding due to these circumstances, which unfortunately is out of our control.
